Tech Campus instructors have been busy preparing for the start of the new school year and have been taking precautions to ensure a safe return to Tech Campus.




SESSION INFO

HEALTH & SAFETY - MASKS REQUIRED

Tech Campus continues to follow protocols set forth by the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH), the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE), and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

Students must monitor their health daily and adhere to the following:

Students should check with their Tech Campus liaison for specific dates and times of bus service to Tech Campus.


OR
