

Are You Earning Transferrable College Credit for Your Project Lead The Way Classes?

If you earned a 6 or greater on the End of **Course Assessment**, you are eligible to apply! FAQ's:

1) I do not plan to attend the University of Iowa. Can I still get credit?

Yes-the college credit is <u>transferrable</u> and is usually transferred into your college of choice as elective credit.

- 2) How many hours of college credit do I earn? You can apply for 3 s.h. of credit for each PLTW class that you score a stanine of 6 or better.
- 3) How much does college credit cost? Each 3 s.h. course is \$150.00.
- 4) Am I eligible for college credit if my school is not a certified PLTW school?
 You are still eligible as long as you scored a 6 or greater on

the End of Course Assessment.

5) I took a PLTW class during the 2014-2015 school yéar and I scored a 6 on the End of Course Assessment. Can I get college credit from a course I took last year?

Yes! It is retroactive. The University of Iowa will allow students to go back one year and earn transferrable transcript credit. The deadline to apply for a class taken in the 2014-2015 school year is July 1, 2016.
