Scholarship Requirements:

- To be eligible for the Tool Scholarship, they must be a first- or second-year student of the Tech Campus Automotive Service Program and be a graduating senior.
- You must show evidence of a desire or plans to continue their pathway within the Automotive field.
- You will need to have at least one of their Tech Campus Automotive Service Instructors provide a reference of eligibility
- A committee of one Tech Campus Auto Service Instructor and two Auto-Service advisory committee members will select applicants and schedule them for an in-person interview.
- The final scholarship recipients will be decided based on the in person committee interviews.
- All applicants will be contacted after the interviews and selections are completed.

Application Should Consist of the Following:

- The application must be fully completed and received by your Automotive Service Instructor by 3:00 pm, **April 1st, 2022.**
- The application must include a statement or letter of your personal character traits from a person who is not a Tech Campus Instructor and not a family member (Current employers and automotive professionals are recommended but not necessary).
- The application must include an attached copy of your Tech Campus Automotive Service Instructor Recommendation.
- Applicants Tech Campus Grades will be pulled and reviewed by the committee.
